It is with great pleasure that the Harvard Club of the United Kingdom presents you with the Harvard Book Prize.

The Prize is awarded to "an outstanding student in the penultimate year, academically excellent, with exceptional personal qualities, who makes a significant contribution to school or community."

The Harvard Book Prize programme was started by alumni in 1910 to encourage talented students such as you to consider applying to Harvard College. Today more than 2,000 Harvard books are awarded all over the world, including 200+ in the UK.

Approximately 30-40 students matriculate to Harvard College each year from the UK. Harvard's policy has always been to find the most talented students and then offer funding packages according to need, not merit. The available grants at Harvard (known as Financial Aid) are possibly the most generous in the US, so don't be dismayed by the "sticker price" of a Harvard education.
